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## 16 - What specific advice would you give to improve student learning in the course?

### Response Rate 9/15 (60%)

• I think that we should have spent a little more time learning how to code. It is very challenging, and while it can be fun, sometimes I feel like I hit dead ends that I struggle to fix with just the Stata manuals.
Economic research is almost always done in teams, so this will continue, but

I personally feel that this would've been a less stressful class if this was an individual project versus a group project.
 I'm going to create more check-in points around team dynamics.
 sometimes the mini lesson in the beginning takes up a lot of time even though i know its important but it makes it hard to work effectively with the group & ask questions while we have the time built

in for it I'm going to experiment with ways to create more time for group work going forward; it requires creativity to do this while also supplying additional time, for example, to practice coding. • Don't have such a broad window of item. Start the research process earlier. We will definitely start the research process earlier in Fall 2024!

• I don't think there's anything specific I need to say. It will improve

• More time in class to complete work, so challenging to complete everything on time and get a good grade.

• More time hands on, making mistakes more often

• I do think it would be particularly helpful if the class structure was more clear, going into the class I was not familiar that we would be using coding platforms and it was not what I envisioned for economic research based on my past economic courses. I think if that was more clear in the beginning I wouldve better acclimated to the course.

• I think your attendance policy isn't practical. I don't agree with how the test are graded because some of mine remained ungraded then that lower my average rate more than I expected.

The class participation policy will stay the same--the groups can't function if members miss to much class. To be clear, there is no explicit attendance policy. There are no tests, so I'm not sure how to address the second part. There are reading quizzes, but they were all graded.
